

Armada Middle School Vocal Music Syllabus

Welcome to our Vocal Music class. We will have an exciting year learning to use our voices as instruments. In this class you will not only be singing, but reading musical literature as well. You will learn music theory, history and technique to enable you to be a better musician and singer.

We will be following the Armada Middle School Standards Based Grading Policy. All grades will be on a four point scale and will be determined based on the following criteria:

Attendance Performance Preparation Participation Tests/Written Assignments

Attendance:

Attendance is mandatory for rehearsals and performances. As this is an ensemble that requires all members to depend on each other, it is essential that all members attend rehearsals and performances. Absences will only be excused from rehearsals if they correspond with the school's attendance policy. Performances will only be excused if a written excuse has been submitted to the director at least 3 weeks in advance of the performance date. Emergency scenarios will be left to the discretion of the director. If a student misses rehearsals and/or performances there will be an opportunity for the student to make up the assignment with an alternate written assignment at the request of the student.

Performance Preparation:

Performance preparation is how a student prepares to perform. You will be expected to know the materials proficiently and work to improve technical skills, (ex. Posture, breathing technique, intonation). If you are prepared, your performances will be outstanding!

Participation:

Participation is required for this class. Students will need to be prepared for class with all materials (music, folder, pencil) and giving their best effort toward improvement for all points to be received. A little effort goes a long way in this class!

Test/Written Assignments:

Tests and/or written assignments will be given weekly. Each assignment will be graded by a point system with a rubric of how points are awarded. If a student is absent they will be expected to make up the assignment.

*There will be a charge for uniforms not returned by the specified date or not in the same condition it was released in. (ex. Holes, rips, tears, etc.) Please notify the director if an accident has occurred at any time with any part of the uniform or dress bag.
